RedEscolas AntiCorruption Programme Schools that inspire a culture of integrity 3rd Edition

REGULATIONS

1. INTRODUCTORY NOTE

The **RedEscolas AntiCorruption Programme - 3rd Edition** (hereinafter the "Programme") is an initiative of **All4Integrity**¹ (hereinafter the "Programme promoter") created as a result of the recognised need to involve Portuguese civil society in preventing and combating corruption.

The Programme's mission is to promote greater proximity between the school public and local and central government institutions, as well as a more in-depth knowledge of the issues surrounding corruption and, consequently, greater civic participation in promoting transparency, integrity, and ethics in the public and private spheres.

The programme also aims to certify the school and its educational community involved in the proposed activities by awarding a *Digital Seal* and an "*AntiCorruption Ambassador School" Certificate*.

2. ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

2.1 Recipients

The programme, which will run for the third time in the 2023/2024 school year, is aimed at students in the 3rd cycle of basic education and secondary education.

The programme aims to promote the implementation of school projects related to the anchor theme of combating corruption and all the others inherent to it (lobbying, conflict of interest, influence peddling, bribery, ethics, transparency, integrity, other adjacent themes). Its interdisciplinary and flexible nature will allow for the development of numerous transversal competences as defined in the Profile of Students Leaving Compulsory Schooling.

2.2 School promoters

In each school, the Programme can be proposed and implemented in the classroom by any educational agent, recognizing the decisive role of teachers, especially head teachers, in promoting the proposed activities.

2.3 Places of action

The Programme was created to be developed in the school context, in an open and direct relationship with the surrounding environment, namely with local and central government institutions.

2.4 Implementation of the Programme

The 3rd Edition of the Programme, under the general theme - Promoting a Path of Integrity - is designed to be applied throughout the 2023/2024 school year and is made up of three pathways:

PATHWAY #1 - Spread the word to raise awareness (July to September 2023);

PATHWAY #2 - Know in order to Act (11 September to 15 December 2023).

PATHWAY #3 - Act to Change (3 January to 19 April 2024).

However, for reasons of school management, schools may find it difficult to apply the entire Pedagogical Roadmap. In this case, and in conjunction with 'The 5 Pillars' defined for the development of the programme, they should preferably carry out Pathways #1 and #2.

During the week of 9 December 2023 - International AntiCorruption Day - there will be a public presentation of the work carried out by the school community during Pathway #2.

Between the 8th and 19th of April 2024, and as part of the *European Youth Information Day* celebrated on the 17th of April 2024, each school should publicly present the work developed along Pathway #3. Each school may select only part of these days for this purpose.

2.5 Certification

During the month of June 2024 and after all the evidence of the application of the Programme by the different Schools has been submitted and analysed, RedEscolas AntiCorruption will award:

- The 'AntiCorruption Ambassador School' certificate to all schools that have joined the programme and provided evidence;
- The 'Gold Digital Seal', the 'Silver Digital Seal' or the 'Bronze Digital Seal', according to the criteria set out in point 3. of these regulations;
- The 'RedEscolas AntiCorruption Ambassador Board' to all schools that have joined the programme and presented evidence identifying all the teachers and students who participated directly in the 3rd Edition.



The Digital Seal aims to promote and certify the projects developed by schools in the area of anti-corruption. The award of the Digital Seal to a school will allow the use of the '*Anti-Corruption Ambassador School*' logo on their websites and official documents.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Interested schools (hereinafter the "Participants") must complete and submit, **between 11 September and 27 October 2023**, the Programme Adherence Form, which will appear on the <u>RedEscolas AntiCorruption website</u>, and the respective Consent for processing personal text and image data for GDPR purposes. These documents must be signed and stamped by the school/group management.

By 30 November 2023, each school must send a table (in Excel format) identifying all the teachers and students who will be directly involved in the 3rd edition of the Programme, as well as their email contacts.

3.1 Framework and validation of submissions

It will be the responsibility of the *RedEscolas AntiCorruption* team to validate the data provided by each school, namely the data relating to the educational institution, as well as the educational agents who will be responsible for coordinating the Programme.

3.2 Selection

An independent jury, appointed by *RedEscolas AntiCorrupção* especially for this purpose, made up of experts from a wide range of fields, including the prevention and fight against corruption, will validate the evidence of the work submitted by the schools. Each member of the jury is responsible for validating a limited number of schools (to be defined by *RedEscolas AntiCorrupção*), with the exception of the President of the Jury, who will validate the work of all the schools, in order to guarantee homogeneity and equity in the validations.

The jury may also decide not to award the *Anti-Corruption Ambassador School certificate*, the respective digital seal and the *RedEscolas AntiCorruption Ambassadors Board* to the school(s) that have not submitted evidence or whose work does not meet the objectives of pathways #1, #2 and #3 of the RedEscolas programme.

3.3 Evaluation Criteria and Awarding of Seals

The jury will analyse all the evidence and validate the schools' evidence (according to each category) according to the following criteria, validated on a scale of one (1) to four (4), for a total of 20 points:

- Appropriateness of the activities carried out in accordance with the General Action Plan presented to the Schools;
- Originality of the work carried out;
- Interdisciplinary nature of the activities carried out;



- Number of agents involved and degree of involvement;
- Impact and dissemination of the projects developed inside and outside the school (e.g. in the community, social networks, media).

Once the validations have been completed, the Jury will decide on the Digital Seals to be awarded, according to the following criteria:

- 'Gold Digital Label' score between 18 (inclusive) and 20;
- 'Silver Digital Seal' score between 14 and 17, inclusive;
- 'Bronze Digital Seal' score between 10 and 13, inclusive;
- No Seal score between 0 and 9 inclusive.

The Jury may also decide to select other criteria, in addition to this benchmark, when deciding on the Digital Seals.

3.4 Final Ceremony of the 3rd Edition of RedEscolas

Participating schools will be contacted directly by the *RedEscolas AntiCorruption* team to hand over the 'AntiCorruption Ambassador School' certificates and the 'RedEscolas AntiCorruption Ambassador Board'.

These certificates and the board will be handed over on 7 June 2024 at a venue to be announced.

The 'Digital Seal' will be sent by email to the school management on a date to be announced.

4. TIMELINE

Without prejudice to changes being made to the Pedagogical Roadmap 2023-2024, here is a timetable of activities:

- from 11 September to 27 October 2023 submission of the 'Participation Application Form';
- 4 December to 15 December 2023 public presentation of the work developed on Route #2;
- **between 11th and 29th December 2023** submission of evidence relating to the activities carried out in Path #2;
- between 8 and 19 April 2024 public presentation of the work carried out on Path #3;
- **between 15 and 26 April 2024** submission of the 'Evidence Report' on the activities carried out on Path #3;



- **between 29 April and 24 May 2024** analysis by the jury of the evidence of the schools' involvement throughout the school year;
- **7 June 2024** Award ceremony for the 'AntiCorruption Ambassador School' certificate and the 'RedEscolas AntiCorruption Ambassador Board'.

5. COMMUNICATION

The Programme's official institutional communication will be carried out via email <u>redescolas@all4integrity.org</u>.

RedEscolas AntiCorrupção reserves the right to appoint a Spokesperson for the Programme, who will be the official representative of the initiative for everything related to it, such as representation in Schools, Town Halls, Parish Councils, Libraries.

6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Each school can submit an unlimited number of projects each year.

Schools wishing to participate with students from years other than those mentioned in point 2.1. of these *Regulations* must notify the *RedEscolas AntiCorruption team* of their intention to do so, so that they can be analysed.

The promoter of the Programme is not responsible for the submission of untimely or faulty applications.

By submitting the Programme application form and accepting these Terms and Conditions, participants authorise the Programme promoter to use the data collected to publicise the Programme, the results and other activities related to the promotion, under the applicable legal terms and in accordance with the *General Data Protection Regulation* (see annex to this *Regulation*).

Participants declare that they own all intellectual property rights to the content and materials submitted during the application of the Programme and may dispose of them under the legal terms. In the event of a proven infringement of intellectual property rights by any of the Participants, the Programme Promoter shall be entitled to compensation from the Participant for any third-party claims in this regard.

Upon request by the Programme Promoter, Participants must provide proof of compliance with the provisions of these *Terms and Conditions*.

All personal information contained in the application form for participation in the Programme is collected, used and kept exclusively for the purposes of administering *RedEscolas AntiCorrupção*.

It is the responsibility of each school to ensure that all evidence submitted (photographs, videos, ...) complies with the *General Data Protection Regulation* (GDPR).

Annex to the RedEscolas AntiCorruption Regulations - 3rd Edition

CONSENT FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION AND IMAGE DATA FOR THE PURPOSES OF GDPR¹

By joining the *RedEscolas AntiCorruption program: Schools that inspire us with a culture of integrity – 3rd Edition*, schools undertake to make this Consent known to parents and students participating in this program, ensuring that they accept, for all legal purposes, consent to the processing of their personal data and grant, free of charge, to All 4 Integrity Association (hereinafter identified as "Association"), as the promoter of this program, the rights to collect, use and preserve their texts and images, as well as the rights of dissemination, publication, use and exploitation of the texts and images of the works carried out by them, under the terms indicated below:

- I Reasoning for the processing of personal data:
 - a) Consent
- II Exclusive purposes of processing personal data:
 - a) The collected personal data are intended exclusively for use in the management of the All4Integrity Association Project – *RedEscolas AntiCorruption – 3rd Edition*, taking place during the 2023/2024 school year;
 - b) Personal data and the work carried out for the project may be used in the production of promotional videos and also reproduced and disseminated at events, on the Association's internal and external communication channels, online and/or offline (namely in the press, email and social networks of the Association: website, Instagram, YouTube, etc.);
 - c) The data will only be used for the purposes for which it is intended, with reference to the authorship of the work carried out by the students always being guaranteed;



- d) Personal data will only be kept as long as they are relevant to the continuity of the project and will be deleted or anonymized when the purpose that motivated the authorization of their processing ceases;
- e) The Privacy Policy available on the Association's website applies to the processing of personal data in question, as well as the national and European legislation in force on the matter, namely the rules of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
 Regulation EU 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016.
- f) Holders of personal data have the right to request access to the personal data concerning them, their rectification, their erasure, limitation of processing with regard to the data subject, opposition to processing, portability of the data, as well as the withdrawal of consent at any time and without any penalty or complaint to the CNPD (National Data Protection Commission) (if the Association is not processing the data lawfully, in accordance with the provisions of the Law and the Privacy Policy). However, the withdrawal of consent does not compromise the lawfulness of the treatment carried out based on the previously given consent.
